

2010-2011 CCBMX Officer Nominations

The By-Laws of Cape Coral BMX call for elections during the Parent Council meeting in September. All officers serve as unpaid volunteers. All officers must submit to and pass a background check by the City of Cape Coral (Jessica Lundsford Law).

President: The President is the Chief Executive Officer of the track, presides over meetings, acts as the contact with the Parks and Recreation Department and the President's signature is required on all checks written from the CCBMX accounts.

Vice President: The Vice President assumes the duties of the President if they are absent. The VP oversees the operation of the Concession Stand and may appoint a concession manager.
